Impact

- Solid knowledge base on the implementation of OS
- Governance and new operational/business models
- European Code of Conduct on OS in transport

Methodology

- Develop a framework of **common understanding**
- Develop an **inventory of OS resources** related to all transport modes
- Set up the **TOPOS Observatory and Forum**, that will act as an evidence-based, community driven sharing of knowledge and experiences
- Develop a **"Code of Conduct"** to provide the legal and ethical guidance needed to operationalize Open Science principles
- Formulate a **set of guidelines** for decision making and planning

Objectives

- Develop a framework to establish a common understanding of operationalizing **Open Science (OS)** in Transport
- Map existing **OS resources** and see how transport research fits in
- Facilitate an **evidence-based dialogue** to promote and establish OS in transport
- Provide the **policy framework** and guidance for open science implementation in transport
- Engage a **broad range of stakeholders** in a participatory process for OS uptake
